HUNTER 146 / 170 MOTOR MOUNT INSTRUCTIONS

Items Included:

- 1. Motor Mount Bracket
- 2. 4 ea #14 x 2" Pan Head Screws

Tools Required:

- 1. 3M 4000, 5200 or comparable marine sealant
- 2. 1/8" drill bit
- 3. 3/8" drill bit
- 4. Drill motor with 3/8 minimum chuck
- 5. # 3 Phillips head screw driver
- 6. Pencil
- 7. Liquid dish soap

Installation:

- Place the motor mount bracket on the mounting pad located to the right (starboard) side of the transom of your boat. The bracket should be faced in such a way that the white plastic mounting block for your engine is facing aft.
- 2. H170: Align the bracket on the pad evenly so that a space of about 3/16" exists on the left and right side of the bracket.
- H146: Align the bracket on the pad so that a space of 3/16" exists on the left and right side of the bracket and the back of the motor mount plastic is approximately even with the outside edge of the rubrail.
- 4. Mark the 4 mounting holes on the deck using a pencil.
- 5. Drill four pilot holes using an 1/8" drill bit centered on the marks. Make sure to drill 1" deep into the deck to ensure that you penetrate the wood backing block.
- 6. Using a 3/8 drill bit, centered on each hole drilled during step 5 drill only through the plastic outer shell of the deck. NOTE: DO NOT DRILL INTO THE WOOD BACKING BLOCK
- Fill each hole with marine sealant, and apply a bead around where the bracket will be placed.
- 8. Screw the bracket securely to the pad using the screws provided.
- Clean excess sealant from around the bracket using a dish soap solution of 10% soap and 90% water.

WARNING!!! This bracket is rated for a maximum engine of 2.5 HP.
