

Innovation in design, excellence in engineering, and an incredible layout make the Hunter 310 the most advanced mid-size cruiser on the market. The interior boasts two private staterooms, each with their own privacy bulkhead, not just a curtain. Great natural light is plentiful throughout the cabin with multiple hatches and screened ports as well as the Hunter wraparound windshield. Entertaining or dining, the salon can handle the family or friends with ease. The large dinette easily converts to a double for extended families and the settees offer plenty of storage as well.

Topsides, the 310 has an immense rounded cockpit that allows all the crew to participate or kick back as they desire. The stern rail seats are up and out of the way, but just may be the best seats in the house! A custom console houses the standard VHF and instruments as well as the engine controls and compass.

The helm seat hinges aft,
leading onto the walk-through
transom complete with
propane tank storage and a
retractable swim ladder along
with a cockpit shower. Above
the cockpit is the integrated
arch which serves as an

attachment point for both the mainsheet as well as the optional bimini. This keeps the cockpit clear, uncluttered and ready for action.

Going forward, you'll see serious non-skid and clear side decks due to the innovative rig arrangement. The B&R



fractional rig with it's sweptback spreaders eliminates the need for a backstay. Mast struts and reverse diagonals give all the strength needed while allowing for a smaller section aloft. For the sailor, this means more stability. If you haven't sailed a Hunter lately, you really owe it to yourself to see what the latest innovations in building production boats can do for you.



Beam reach or hard on the wind, the 310 has the versatility in the sailplan to do it all. The absence of the backstay allows for a large roach main and a small furling jib. Adjustments are quick and easy.



An athwartship Queen-size berth adorns the master stateroom. Twin hanging lockers and plenty of storage combined with excellent headroom make staying aboard a pleasure.



The forward stateroom has it's own locker and storage as well as a real privacy door and great ventilation. Perfect for the kids or for weekend guests.

Normally galleys like this are only found on 35 footers. Removable trash bin, large, stainless steel sink, two burner range, microwave and a deep icebox are all at hand. Stowage is both above and below the generous countertops.



Corian® counters and easily maintained surfaces make this large head easy to use with the standard hot shower and marine head.



Swimming, diving, or just loading the tender is easy from the walkthrough transom and swim platform.



Attachment of the mast struts are secure and inboard to keep the sidedecks free and clear.



Coaming wells keep the halyards and sheets neat and organized. All lines lead aft to the cockpit to make short-handed sailing easier.



Engine access is quick and complete with the tilt out and removable insulated engine cover. The 18 HP Yannar is powerful, reliable and economical.



The deep anchor well can hold plenty of rode and chain and provides a mount point for the optional windlass as well as the standard anchor roller.

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
