




RIGGING: Dacron sails; main and 110% genoa; jiffy reefing, main; sheets; double spreader fractional rig; two two-speed selftailing sheet winches; self-tailing halyard winch; line organizer; internal halyards, pre-stretched dacron; mid-boom sheeting; adjustable mainsheet traveler; inboard genoa tracks with cars; boom vang; anodized aluminum mast and boom; Windex®.

DECK: Anodized aluminum toe rail; bow pulpit, stainless steel; stern rail, stainless steel; double lifelines; mooring cleats; teak handrails; on-deck anchor well; anchor roller; cabin skylight; molded-in two-tone non-skid deck; stainless steel swim ladder.
