

The interior layout exhibits many features we have found ideal in charter cruising. Among them are two equally large master staterooms, each with its own head and shower. In addition, there is a third double cabin to starboard complete with head and vanity which makes it an ideal choice for three couples looking for a memorable and affordable sailing experience. It's also good for two couples bringing along a skipper or cook.

On the 432, the entire seating arrangement is located off-centerline to Port providing an


unobstructed passageway forward. Outboard from the Starboard passageway is a well appointed galley that demonstrates both utility and elegance. The 432's deck and cockpit provides for both comfortable lounging and unencumbered sail handling while her innovative transom design incorporates a boarding ladder and storage for swim equipment.

Built by Beneteau to the exacting standards required by The Moorings, our new performance cruiser is available for placement in our charter fleet and private purchase.
